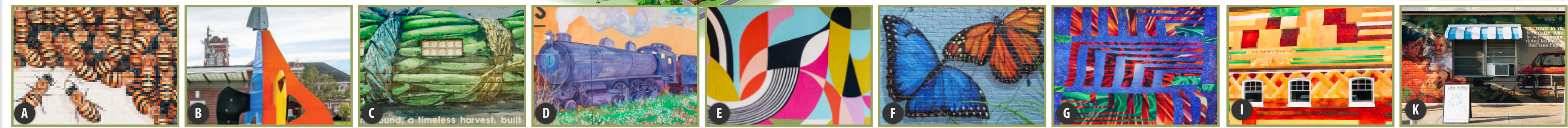


WHAT'S NEW FOR 2024?

Newly constructed studio spaces offer artists a dedicated location to hone their practice, explore new ideas, and find community with other artists. A first of its kind in Lake City, Acline Studios will include individual spaces for artists to rent, a gallery for exhibitions and programming, and art equipment, starting with a soda kiln. Acline Studios will serve as our Welcome Center for the 2024 festival and you can stop by at 3PM each day for a full tour at 132 North Acline Street.

ARTFIELDS WELCOMES YOU TO THE 2024 ANNUAL FESTIVAL!

STEP ONE: REGISTER

It's finally time for one of the South's biggest art festivals! To make the most out of your trip, follow our easy four step process. First, **register** to vote for the People's Choice Awards. You can do this online via artfieldssc.org or when you get to Lake City. Once you arrive in town, activate your voter registration at the Welcome Center at 132 N Acline Street, Jones-Carter Gallery at 105 Henry Street, TRAX Visual Art Center at 122 Sauls Street, or the ROB at 245 S Church Street. Then grab a Field Guide and download the free Bloomberg Connects app to access the competition artwork via the ArtFields guide.

STEP TWO: EXPLORE

Artwork is in over 50 venues around downtown Lake City. We recommend you **explore** every location, conveniently marked with an orange venue sticker and sidewalk decal! Student artwork in the ArtFields Jr. Competition is in venues marked with blue venue decals. Use the numbered venue markers on the back of this map to navigate around town. At each art piece, you will see a label that includes an artist statement about the work, plus the name of the artist and artwork information. Be sure to ask one of our friendly volunteers if you need any help while you're out and about. Grab the promotional cards that accompany artworks as a memento and a reminder of your favorites!

Part of what makes our competition & festival special is that artwork surrounds you no matter where you are in town! During your time in Lake City, remember to **enjoy** a bite to eat or a fun purchase from one of our local businesses. There are also ways to immerse yourself in art in addition to the competition artwork. Learn about the art of horticulture at Moore Farms Botanical Garden, take a dive into the world of textiles and repurposing with artist Corinne Loperfido, and discover public art all around town. There's a lot to enjoy everywhere you go and if you need any help, just ask a volunteer in the green shirt for help!

STEP THREE: ENJOY

Put on your art critic hat and help us decide the People's Choice Winners! After you've seen the competition artwork, **vote** for your favorite pieces. Can't decide? No problem, you can vote for multiple artworks that you saw and liked, but each individual piece only once. Anyone 16 and up can vote on the adult competition artwork. One 2D and 3D artist will walk away with \$12,500 each, so be sure to vote! Either vote on a desktop computer at artfieldssc.org with your voter ID number or text the voting code to 843-647-6780. Students in grades 1 - 12 can vote on the ArtFields Jr. Competition Artwork with paper ballots inside ArtFields Jr. venues.
